Château L'Ermitage 'Tradition' Blanc 2014, Costières de Nîmes, France 2 bottles £10

Situated on the south facing hills rolling towards the Mediterranean, Château L'Ermitage enjoys both optimal sunshine and cooling sea breezes. The result is juicy fruit with delightful even ripeness and flavour which the winemakers strive to preserve with minimal oak contact. This fleshy, fresh blend of Rousanne, Grenache Blanc and Viognier evokes the Mediterranean: orange blossom, ripe stone fruit and citrus. Bon Voyage!

It has an elegant balance of fruit and spice with a delicate savoury wrapper. Conditions in the Awatere Valley allow the fruit to ripen slowly, retaining a lively freshness that we find in this great value Pinot Gris. No wonder it disappeared so quickly last time.

Domaine Langlois-Château Saumur 2012, Loire, France 2 bottles £11

Yet another fine wine from Langlois-Château! We love this Loire Valley red for all the right reasons: its colour, a beautiful bright red with a purple hue, its nose, bursting with blackcurrants and raspberries and its palate, leafy, juicy and mouth-watering. This light-medium weight Cabernet Franc is a perfect spring red to enjoy on its own or with a platter of charcuterie.

This month we bring you their organic Malbec from the Rapel Valley where mild springs, warm summers and alluvial soils favour fruit development. A lively, lighter style, Malbec with dark fruit and cherry flavours and silky texture. First BBQ of the season maybe?

Dolcetta d'Alba Pian Balbo 2013, Poderi Colla, Piemonte, Italy 2 bottles £12

A new arrival at BinTwo and one that brings a smile. 100% Dolcetto from the well-reputed 'Colla' family's Barbaresco vineyards. Bright cherry and plum fruits with expressive varietal notes including herbs and spice. This red is both lightweight and refreshing, with smooth textured finish, pairing nicely with a savoury mushroom and chorizo risotto à la Margot's Bistro.

Puy de Dome Pinot Noir Rosé 2013, Loire, France 2 bottles £11

Hats off to the Cave Saint-Verny in the Auvergne district of the Loire Valley for this single varietal rosé. Similar in style to a Sancerre rosé (also made from Pinot Noir): dry, vibrant and full of juicy summer fruits. However, unlike the onion-skin hue of a Sancerre, this wine has a lovely salmon-pink colour. A gorgeous aperitif.
